Kinabatangan river

- The **Kinabatangan River** (Malay: *Sungai Kinabatangan*) is a river in Sandakan Division, northeastern Sabah of Malaysia. It is the second longest river in Malaysia with a length of 560 km (350 mi) from its headwaters in the mountains of southwest Sabah, to its outlet at the Sulu Sea, east of Sandakan. The Kinabatangan river is one of the best and most easily accessible places to see wildlife in Asia! The population density of animals on this stretch of the Kinabatangan river is second to none, including so much of Sabah's most sought after wildlife: Orang-utans, proboscis monkeys, pygmy elephants, langurs, wild cats, crocodiles, amazing birdlife and much much more.

Tour Itinerary

- 12.00 - Pick up from your respective hotel lobby or airport and proceed to Kinabatangan River, which take about 2-3 hours drive from the city.
- 14.30p - Upon arrival, you will be greeted by the local crew and refreshment will be served.
- 16.00 - River safari start. Cruise along the river in search of endemic wildlife like proboscis monkey, orang utan, macaques, pygmy elephants, birds and many more.
- 18.00 - An early dinner will be served at the lodge.
- 19.30 - After dinner, return to Sandakan. Drop off at Sandakan Airport or at your respective hotel.
